Every member of staff is required to:

- Work towards and promote the vision, beliefs, aims and expectations of the school
- Support and contribute to the achievement of every child's outcomes
- Support and contribute to the safeguarding of all students
- Undertake professional development activities to enhance personal development and performance
- Maintain high personal professional standards of attendance, punctuality, appearance, conduct and positive relations with students, parents and staff.

Main purpose of role:

 To work under the direction and instruction of Senior staff to undertake individually, or as part of a team, the cleaning of designated areas and associated accommodation to ensure they are kept in a clean and hygienic condition.

Main Activities

• Maintenance and Cleaning

Carry out cleaning tasks as directed by the appropriate supervisor to include:

- Clean toilets, bowls, sinks and basins
- Wipe down desks and chairs
- Vacuum and tidy classrooms
- Wash worktops/tables
- Wash/mop/sweep floors and wash wet areas
- Clean inside glazing
- Dust and polish
- Use buffer
- Strip and reseal floors (occasionally)
- Undertake routine maintenance of equipment (e.g. vacuum bags)
- Empty bins and dispose of rubbish
- Ensure safe and effective use and storage of all equipment
- Be aware of Health and Safety at Work regulations and COSHH guidelines
- Cleaning of toilet facilities and associated tasks required to achieve a high quality of cleanliness.
- Cleaning of fixtures and fittings.
- The use of appropriate cleaning equipment and machinery.
- Ensuring the safe use of chemicals, machinery and equipment when carrying out the cleaning function in line with current legislation, standards and County Council policies and procedures for Health and Safety and in accordance with training provided.
- Draw to caretaker's attention any problems / issues which may affect the safety or security of the school or its users.
