



The Avon Valley School Uniform - A Guide for Parents and Carers



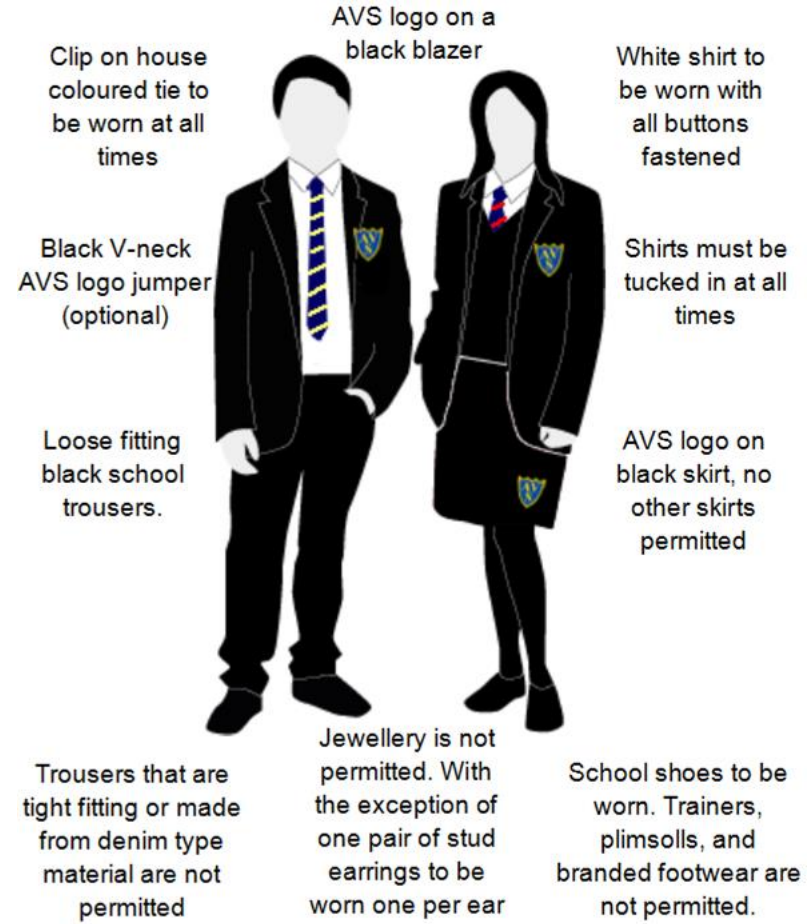
Uniform

Students are expected to wear full school uniform, including a blazer, at all times, including when travelling to and from school and within the school premises, unless advised by a member of staff.

We want our students to look smart and to be proud of their appearance.

Item	Boys' Uniform	Girls' Uniform
Outside Coat	Black or Navy Blue (plain in colour)	
Blazer	Black with AVS Badge. Compulsory.	
Shirt	White. Standard school shirt	
Tie	Dark blue clip on tie with House colours	
Jumper	V-Neck black with embroidered school badge. Optional. Other jumpers are not allowed.	
Trousers	Black school trousers. Denim, cords, leggings, tight fitting trousers are not allowed.	
Skirt		Black, pleated, knee length, with AVS logo
Tights		Natural. Thick black in winter.
Socks	Black	Black
Shoes	Plain black shoes. Trainers, pumps or boots are not allowed.	

Uniform Guidance



So that all students look smart...

- Shirts must be tucked in
- All buttons are to be fastened
- Blazers are to be worn at all times
- Jewellery is not permitted except for one pair of stud earrings. Other piercings are not allowed
- Hair styles must be suitable for the school environment. Which means hair colourings are not permitted unless a single natural colour. Shaved hair must not be below a grade 2, lines are not allowed to be shaved in the hair.
- Neither nail extensions or varnish are allowed

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PE and Dance Kit Guidance



PE Kit Item	Boys	Girls
Polo shirt	Navy/sky blue with AVS logo	
Rugby shirt	Navy/Sky blue reversible with AVS logo	
Zipped top (optional)	Navy/Sky blue with AVS logo	
Shorts or skorts	Navy blue with AVS logo	Shorts Navy with AVS logo Skort Navy/Sky blue with AVS logo
Socks	Navy Blue with sky blue top	
Tracksuit bottoms (optional)	Navy Blue with AVS logo	
Leggings/skins (optional)	Navy Blue to only to be worn under shorts/skort	
Trainers (not pumps)	Suitable for indoor and outdoor lessons with sufficient grip and support	
Football boots	Suitable boots with sufficient support and studs/blades for soft ground (your child will be told at what point in the year these are needed as feet grow so quickly!)	
Kit bag	A suitable named kit bag to keep all PE kit in	
Gum shield	Compulsory for Rugby lessons (also available in school for £2)	
Shin pads	Compulsory for football lessons/matches (also available in school for £3)	
Dance polo shirt	Black with AVS Logo	
Dance Leg Wear	Black Jogging Bottoms	Black Jogging Bottoms or Leggings

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Styles of Shoe

The following examples are to be used as a guide when purchasing shoes for your son or daughter.

We are fully aware that many shoe retailers sell 'trainers' as shoes and, as a parent, this makes your decision as to what to buy very difficult. There is a very 'grey' area when it comes to purchasing trainers that look like shoes.

The vast majority of 'trainers' brands are unacceptable. These include Nike, Reebok, Champion, La Coste ...etc. Even if they are completely black they are still trainers and so are not acceptable at school. No 'flip flop' style of shoes will be allowed in school and all school shoes should be completely black in colour.
